Frequently Asked Questions

Latte Art Classes

As per the dates on the website, they run every two weeks on a Wednesday night from 7 pm to approx. 9:30 pm. We have a maximum of 6 attendees, with one barista for every three persons attending.

The class costs £50 per person and covers coffee bean selection, the grinder, grinding coffee, dosing, tamping and extraction of the coffee, then focusses heavily on steaming and texturing milk and pouring patterns in the last half of the class.

It is a hands-on class, that will include loads of tips and tricks for pouring latte art.

This class is a great introduction to coffee making and latte art for the home enthusiast or a person who may want to get into being a barista or even the starting point of opening your own café.

One on One Classes

The one on one (or one on two) class is simply just one person (and a friend if you wish) and our lead barista purely focussing on coffee, the espresso machine and link in fine detail. This is a fantastic course to really get a good idea of what life behind the coffee machine is like in one of the U.K.'s best coffee shops. Classes run from 7 pm to approx. 9:30 pm.

The course costs £130 for one person, or £195 for two people. Starting with the beans then the grinder, moving onto the grind profile to espresso recipes, dosing and tamping, extraction and shot assessment, then onto milk steaming and texturing and pouring latte art. You will also go over lots of tips and tricks, systems and processes in order to help make the best possible coffee.

These classes are run 'on demand' and we hold them when we know that both the attendee and our lead barista are available.

Where are they held?

All classes are held at our flagship store at 15 Eastcastle street, Fitzrovia W1T 3AY. It is 3 minute walk from either Tottenham Court road station or Oxford Circus station and is one street back from Oxford street.

How do I book and pay?

For the latte art classes, the easiest way is to call our Eastcastle street store direct and ask to speak to a manager on duty, they will be glad to assist.

For the 1 on 1 classes, you can also call the store, or you can email us to check availability first and then call to pay.

You can also drop into store personally and have a coffee at the same time.



What if it is a gift for someone?

Great idea, it is a perfect gift for the coffee person in your life. We can either email or post you out a voucher for the class, as well as a letter of explanation about who we are and what the class is all about.

Do I have to choose a date?

You can if you want to, or you can leave the date open ended. Just let us know when you book. For the one on one classes, we always have to check the availability of our trainers first, so you can leave it open ended for your recipient to book themselves or you can provide us with a few dates that suit you so we can try to find a match.

Do you provide food?

We do provide light savoury snacks, but we do recommend you eat beforehand if you can as you may be ingesting a bit off coffee and it is best to do so on a full stomach.

Do I have to drink the coffee?

No, not necessary. We very much understand that it is after 7 pm and you may not get any sleep if you drink too much. Or you can drink as much as you like....

Do you provide certificates?

We are sorry but we do not, as it is not a certified course. However, if required we can provide you with a 'letter of completion' if you need it. Please just ask for it by email.

Can I do the courses in the daytime?

Again, we are sorry but as the course is held outside of normal operating hours we can only do it from 7 pm onwards (6 pm on a Sunday).
